We ask that when you give permission for your child to participate in a school approved activity on SchoolBytes, and there is a fee attached, you pay the fee at the same time you give permission. It is easy to forget that you have given permission but not paid the fee. Much appreciated.

Attendance Award - Explained Absences!

Congratulations Kindergarten with 73% of absences explained. Extra play for our smallest Buninyongers this week plus 2 tokens to spend at the fete.

The attendance area we are concentrating on for the next few weeks is explained absences. Currently Stage 1 only have 44% of their absences explained. Stage 2 have 62% explained and Stage 3 have only 44% explained. I ask families that every absence their children has from school is explained. This can be done through the SchoolBytes app, a phone call to the office or a note sent into the teacher.

Attendance Policy Guidelines for Justified Absences

Parents of children from Kindergarten to Year 12 must ensure their children attend school every day. On occasion, your child may need to be absent from school. Justified reasons for student absences may include:

being sick or having an infectious disease

having an unavoidable medical appointment

being required to attend a recognised religious holiday

exceptional or urgent family circumstances e.g. attending a funeral.

Parents must provide an explanation for absences to the school within 7 days from the first day of any period of absence. Where an explanation has not been received within the 7-day timeframe, the school will record the absence as unexplained on the student's record.

School jumpers

As the weather is getting cooler and jumpers are coming to school I ask that school uniform jumpers, labelled with your child's name, are worn to school and that expensive sloppy joes are left at home. It causes distress if special jumpers can't be found. Your cooperation is very much appreciated.
