

Teacher / Staff Managed Behaviours

Teacher Intervention at all stages **D** Prompt

- **D** Redirect
- **D** Reteach

Intervention 1
Implement classroom
behaviour management
system.
Student moved to first
warning on the behaviour
chart. Reteach behaviour.

Intervention 2

If the behaviour continues student moved to time out in the classroom to reflect. Teacher conference after time out. Reteach the expectations.

Student placed on Make Good Choices. Teacher ensures that there is prompting and redirection to stay on task.

Intervention 3

Student sent to Buddy Class. Complete executive referral. Mark as 'blue card'. Teacher conference with student about expectations.

Intervention 4

When classroom management strategies have not worked send red card for executive assistance.

Minor incidents are teacher managed. Major incidents are executive managed.

Chronic Minor infractions

Data Decision Rule: If a student has 3 teacher managed incidents, for the same behaviour over the course of a week then escalation to an executive managed incident may be required.
